Back Street Tour (Private Basis)

Real Kyoto is hidden on Back Streets! You'll visit Gion where is famous for Geisha district and filled with teahouses where Geisha entertain. Also cycling Kyoto Imperial Palace Park (Old residences of the Imperial family) makes you freshen up!

The tour visit...

Miyagawacho, Gion, River Shirakawa and Kyoto Imperial Palace Park

Cycling distance: Approximately 15 kilometers

*Departures: Daily (except Jan. 01-09 & Dec. 29-31, 2012)

Pick up service or drop off service are not available and please assemble at Kyoto Station Cycle Terminal near JR Kyoto station.

AM (or PM) tour: Starts at 9:30 (or 13:30) and ends at 12:30 (or 16:30). (Approx. 3 hours)

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Saga Arashiyama & World Heritage Tour (Private Basis)

Away from downtown, enjoy the bike ride to Arashiyama in the outskirts of Kyoto. Visit two World Heritage sites, Kinkaku-ji Temple (Golden Pavilion), Ryoan-ji Temple with Japan's most famous rock garden or Tenryu-ji Temple which has been ranked first among Kyoto's "Five Great Zen Temples". Moreover, you'll cycle bamboo groves, Togetsukyo Bridge, literally meaning "Crossing Moon Bridge" with Mt. Arashiyama as backdrop. This is absolutely perfect course for Cycling!

The tour visit...

Kinkaku-ji Temple (Golden Pavilion)*, Ryoan-ji Temple*, Tenryu-ji Temple* (Choose 2 temples from *), Hirose Pond, Bamboo Forest and Togetsukyo Bridge.

Cycling distance: Approximately 12 kilometers

*Departures: Daily (except Jan. 01-09 & Dec. 29-31, 2012)

Pick up service is available at your hotel in Kyoto and transfer to Kinkakuji Cycle Terminal by local transportation or taxi with assistant.
